

- Plastic bags
- · Plastic lids & caps
- Plastic 6-pack holders
- Needles or syringes
- · Plastic microwave trays
- Frozen food, ice cream or frozen juice containers
- Window panes, mirrors, ceramics & Pyrex dishware
- · Plastics other than those listed
- · Paint, pesticides, oil & cleansers
- Stickers or address label sheet waste
- Waxed paper or waxed cardboard
- · Styrofoam or paper to-go containers
- · Organic material and food waste
- Electronic waste (batteries, cell phones, computers, etc.)

## NO NEED TO REMOVE:

Paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, metal fasteners, cellophane address windows, rubber bands, spiral bindings, plastic tabs

Please flatten all cardboard boxes. Empty and rinse all containers.
